Nurs FPX 4010 Assessment 4 Communication Skills

Nurs FPX 4050 Assessment 2 Ethical and Policy Factors in Care

This assessment asks you to develop a presentation for a local community organization or support group on an ethical issue that relates to the [NURS FPX 4050 Assessment 2 Ethical and Policy Factors in Care](#). You are required to incorporate relevant change theories, such as Lewin's Planned Change Theory, into your presentation. In addition, you must demonstrate a thorough understanding of the Code of Ethics for Nurses.

This code emphasizes that nurses must use sound judgement to make decisions about patient care and uphold the values of nonmaleficence, fidelity, and truth telling. It also stresses that nurses should collaborate with other healthcare professionals to promote health and reduce disparities.

In addition, nurses must be aware of national policy development and implementation. This includes policies affecting access to healthcare services, such as the Affordable Care Act. It also encompasses societal goals such as Healthy

People 2020. These goals include achieving high-quality life free from disease and disability, increasing longevity, and integrating social justice into healthcare.

Nurs FPX 4030 Assessment 1 Locating Credible Databases and Research

Nurses often deal with a lot of information and identifying credible sources is challenging. Fortunately, there are some online tools that can help nurses determine which articles and journals provide accurate information. One way to do this is by using the CRAAP method, which stands for currency, authority, relevance, accuracy, and purpose. Another helpful tool is the HJRS, which can identify fraudulent websites and journals.

The [nurs fpx 4030 assessment 1 locating credible databases and research](#) focuses on interprofessional collaboration and locating resources to support evidence-based practice. The assessment requires students to make a 5-minute video reflecting on an experience with interprofessional coordinated effort and to research the topic. Students should also use the Capella library to locate relevant research and databases for their topic.

To successfully complete this assessment, it is important for students to stay organized. This can be done by keeping track of deadlines with a calendar or creating a dedicated study area at home or work. It is also helpful to have someone review your work before submission.

Nurs FPX 3700 Assessment 4 Conflict Negotiation

During conflict, it is essential that the individual involved considers the concerns of both parties to reach a compromise. This is referred to as integrative negotiation or a win-win approach. This strategy will help both parties to preserve their relationships and achieve a positive outcome. A lose-win situation may cause both individuals to feel resentful and it can also affect the overall satisfaction of customers.

Despite the fact that some participants felt they had not assimilated all of the [FPX 3700 Assessment 4 Conflict Negotiation](#), most reported making some changes to their approach to resolving conflicts involving people and resources. These included increasing persistence in trying to negotiate, putting themselves in others' shoes and being prepared to offer alternative solutions.

They also incorporated the use of the negotiation toolkit into their work practices. However, a number of barriers were identified to the implementation and use of negotiation skills including time, negotiating with internal/external parties (especially with the health department), job mobility, and standardization of negotiations as an integral part of daily work.
